To get maximum play out of his Greek Revival farmhouse, architect Gil Schafer—along with designer Miles Redd—devised its public room to perform duo roles with equal importance: “Miles and I designed the big table to double as both a dining and a library table,” says Schafer. “When I’m not serving dinner there, it’s stacked with books.” Schafer covered a very inexpensive table with a cloth and drilled holes in the table top (and the cloth) to run lamp wires down to plugs in the floor: “I dim the lamps for a soft glow at dinner.”
